Fitting the shirt

The open tail end makes fitting and removing the shirt very easy.

- 1. With small pets (short legs) it is easier to insert the head first followed by each front leg. With larger dogs (long legs) it is easier to insert one leg followed by the head and then the other leg.
- 2. The Medical Pet Shirt should then be pulled back as far as possible over your pets' body.
- 3. Fasten using the poppers at the tail end of the shirt
- 4. There are 2 tabs on the inside of the shirt which can be used to thread through the dogs collar.
- 5. The shirt should neither be too tight or too loose, with minimal sagging around the abdomen. You can determine a good fit by holding the neck of the shirt at the pet's neck then stretching the shirt by approx. 50%, the base of the tail should sit in place accordingly with the shirt.

When needing the toilet

When your dog needs to go to the toilet simply:

- 1. Undo the shirt at the tail end and roll up.
- 2. Using the tab on the underside, inside the shirt (chest region) and the popper on the outside of the shirt to fasten back.
- 3. Afterwards unfasten roll back and refasten.

Washing

The Medical Pet Shirt can be machine washed at 30°C (86.0°F).











Your MPS will need washing if visibly dirty, if any urine, faeces or wound discharge has leaked through the shirt.

Uses

Post-operative care

The Medical Pet Shirt can help to reduce stress and fear which can increase discomfort after an operation.

Will help to keep your pet warm after surgery.

Reduce the chance of your pet interfering with the wound.

May help to hold dressings in place.

Skin disease and wounds

The Medical Pet Shirt will help protect fragile skin and will help reduce damage due to interference with the affected area.

The Medical Pet Shirt is a part of the management process and may be used as an adjunct to appropriate therapy. Wounds and skin conditions should be appropriately assessed and managed by a veterinary professional.

If your pet's condition does not improve, if your pet appears to be distressed, or continues licking or scratching then you should seek veterinary advice.

In season and incontinence

The shirt is double lined so a pad can be inserted into the shirt to reduce blood and urine stains around the house.

Important

We recommend regular checking of the shirt to ensure correct fit and that there is no irritation to your pet's skin.

It is advised that the shirt be removed every few days for washing and checking of the affected area. Always follow the advice given from your veterinary practice.
